Dear P-H-M Middle School Student and Family,

Another winter is just around the corner, and again we must think about the possibility of bad weather, school closings, and lost instructional time.

There are no snow make-up days built into the 2017 - 2018 school calendar this year. Penn-Harris-Madison has again been approved by the Indiana Department of Education to use eLearning lessons on the day of a school closing. eLearning stands for *electronic learning* that can be accomplished by students working on their Chromebooks or a computer from home through the internet.

Each middle school student will have eLearning lessons for every class. Teachers will maintain up-to-date eLearning assignments that students can access on their Chromebooks. Teachers will have assignments posted at the normal school day start time and be available by email during regularly scheduled school hours on days when school is closed and eLearning takes place.

Please see the *Middle School Technology Instructions for eLearning* on the back of this letter. This sheet will provide the instructions that you and your child will need when you access the eLearning lessons. Please contact your child's Principal with questions you may have.

In the event that your child has an IEP and receives direct service minutes during the school day, the Exceptional Education teacher will contact parents to make alternative arrangements if necessary.

Parent Canvas: Username/Password:

- The Canvas parent access Login is your **parent HAC username and parent HAC password**. As a Parent you have view-only rights. Password help is available through email at HAC@phm.k12.in.us or you can contact your Guidance Counselor.

Student Canvas: Username/Password:

- The Canvas student access Login is first initial+last name+last 3 digits of student ID. Password is Student ID#+phm.

Canvas Navigation:

- Once you are in Canvas, hover over **Courses** (top toolbar) and you will be able to drop down and see your child's courses. You can check **Announcements** and the **Calendar** for each class.

Scores:

- Grades for assignments given through Canvas are posted on Canvas. Parents can choose to have updated Canvas scores sent to them if that feature is activated through Preferences. All Progress Report and Report Card grades will show up on HAC.
